We'll stop at a traditional working farm, nursery and greenhouse, growing organic produce and raising beef, pork and lamb with no antibiotics or hormones.

We'll meet Cherokee/Shawnee artist Gary Marc Henson, who is perhaps best known for his work on the The Five Moons sculptures at THSM.

We'll learn about Andy Payne, 20-year-old Cherokee from Foyil, who ran 3,423.5 miles, a world record, by completing the distance from Los Angeles to New York City in 573 hours, 4 minutes, 34 seconds, in the "Bunion" race, winning \$25,000.

We'll have a "lunch and learn session" in Chelsea and a Native dinner in Claremore.
